Rotary Club Website Front Page

- ▶ This is your best chance to attract new members
- ▶ What are potential members looking for ?
- ▶ Make sure that information that may be relevant is front and centre
 - ▶ Who are you ?
 - ▶ What do you do ?
 - ▶ When and where your Club meets
 - ▶ Why should I consider joining ?
 - ▶ How can I get more information ?
 - ▶ CONSIDER HAVING A PHONE NUMBER ON WEBSITE
 - ▶ ? Prepaid SIM card in dedicated phone



What should I use for my Webpage ?

- ▶ Depends on the size of your Club and what you want from a website
- ▶ Whatever platform you choose it should be easily updatable
- ▶ Website should be able to be updated by someone with basic skills
 - ▶ WordPress
 - ▶ Squarespace
 - ▶ ClubRunner
- ▶ All are CMS (Content Managed Sites) that are easily maintained and updated
