## Rotary Club Website Front Page

  - What do you do?
  - When and where your Club meets
  - Why should I consider joining?
  - ► How can I get more information?
  - CONSIDER HAVING A PHONE NUMBER ON WEBSITE
    - > ? Prepaid SIM card in dedicated phone





## What should I use for my Webpage?

- Depends on the size of your Club and what you want from a website
- Whatever platform you choose it should be easily updatable
- Website should be able to be updated by someone with basic skills
  - WordPress
  - Squarespace
  - ClubRunner
- All are CMS (Content Managed Sites) that are easily maintained and updated
